2016 Town Hall Questionnaire

1. Do you support a mutual separation between religion and government?
2. Surveys indicate that there is a great deal of prejudice against the nonreligious in America. Would you have any hesitation in appointing a well-qualified nontheist candidate to a leadership position in your administration?
3. Would your religious beliefs influence public health care policy as it relates to access for reproductive health care?
4. Do you support comprehensive, evidence-based, and medically accurate sex education curriculum in public schools?
5. Do you believe religious organizations that receive government funds to provide social services should be required to comply with federal policies and regulations even if those policies conflict with the religious beliefs of the organization?
6. U.S. Armed Forces chaplains provide emotional and moral support without the stigma, confidentiality, and accessibility challenges of mental health services, yet no chaplains represent the 1/4 of service members who are nonreligious, nonbelievers, or humanists. Do you support humanist chaplains joining the Chaplaincy Corps?
7. How will you further climate change policy when key congressional leaders deny the overwhelming scientific consensus that it is happening and that human activity is the primary cause?
